What is a Young Authors Fair (YAF)?

Writing is a wonderful skill to cultivate in our children. Just think of where our country would be if our forefathers had not been able to write our Constitution! Our children may not currently be penning a document as critical as the Constitution, but they may be communicating something as vital as the love of God to someone in desperate need of a Savior. Because of this, we encourage our students to grow in excellence in writing. We also recognize that it is a growing and learning process.

And so, we have a YAF to celebrate their progress! Young authors are invited to put their "best stuff" out on the table for all to see. Whether it is a short story or a 500-page novel, or something in between, our young authors are invited to write and display their original penned work at the YAF.

What is a Living History Night (LHN)?

History comes to life, as portrayed by our students and parents who dress in costume according to the attire their historical persona might have worn. Are you studying a certain era in history? Choose someone from that era, and come dressed in costume. There will be a parade of the historical characters.
